TRANSFORMATIVE PROJECT

Critical Corridor

Connections Warsaw was one of only three communities in the state chosen to participate in a Community Centered Economic Inclusion program led by Brookings Institution and Local Initiatives Support Corporation (LISC).

KEDCO helped lead efforts to co-create an economic inclusion plan for the City of Warsaw. More than 40 stakeholders were involved in the project, and KEDCO had 180+ engagements with stakeholders throughout the process.

Findings have already led to a feasibility study for a downtown performing arts center. The project is funded by the Indiana Economic Development Corporation.

IMPACT STORY

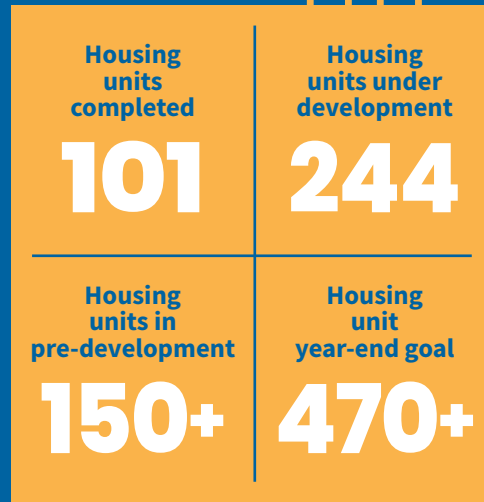
In response to discussions at a KEDCO Talent Think Tank, Ivy Tech hosted its first-ever “Learn While You Earn” hiring fair for employers who offer tuition assistance. **Sixteen local employers** participated in the event and **57 job offers** were made.



HOUSING

Building upon our Housing Initiative

A housing needs study showed market potential for 2,000+ additional units in Kosciusko County, and KEDCO was identified to lead county-wide housing efforts to create more market rate, workforce housing, with a key focus on proximity to employment centers.



TRANSFORMATIVE PROJECTS

Gatke Lofts KEDCO is working alongside the City of Warsaw and Rebar Development to rehabilitate and develop the former Gatke warehouse and factory site located along the Argonne Corridor in Warsaw. The Gatke project will offer a unique mix of housing, flexible office/studio options, and commercial space.

Millworks KEDCO is working alongside the City of Warsaw and AP Development LLC to develop the former Owen's site in downtown Warsaw. The 2-acre site will include an 85-unit market rate apartment building with commercial space available on the first floor.

Eastfield Housing In May 2023, a groundbreaking was held for the Eastfield housing development in Milford. Development is led by Miller Brothers Builders, and will bring 50+ single-family homes to the area. KEDCO worked alongside the Town of Milford to bring this project to life.

DOWNTOWN BUSINESS STUDIO

In Spring 2023, KEDCO relocated its offices and established the Downtown Business Studio in Warsaw.

KEDCO offices are located on the 3rd floor.

The Workspace, located on the second floor, is a membership-based shared classroom-style space. It's ideal for entrepreneurs, solopreneurs, remote workers, or road warriors who do not have a Kosciusko office location.

The Market, coming this fall to the first floor, will include a café-style space with pop-up retail from local businesses. It's an ideal opportunity to test drive a retail business!

BUILDING A PIPELINE OF STARTUP COMPANIES

KEDCO and venture studio firm, **NEXT Studios** launched a medical technology-focused business accelerator program to develop a pipeline of startup companies to complement and advance the local orthopedic sector. Eleven startup founders have participated to-date, and another cohort of the program will begin in Fall 2023.

HELP KOSCIUSKO

The Hoosier Enduring Legacy Program (HELP), housed by KEDCO, has 21 volunteer-led projects in process to help equip and build long-term capacity in our rural communities.

IMPACT STORY

Co-founders of local medtech startup, **GemViz**, first began sharing business ideas at a KEDCO Entrepreneur Social before launching the company in August 2023. GemViz also participated in the accelerator program.



THE PODCAST

Clearly Kosciusko – The Podcast

The Clearly Kosciusko Podcast features guests from different backgrounds and walks of life, all with unique professional and personal experiences. Whether they have roots in the community, journeyed here later in life, launched a business, or are a part of our strong workforce, the podcast is a collection of diverse stories with the common denominator being Kosciusko County or “K-County.”

In early 2023, KEDCO established a partnership with DreamOn Studios to improve and amplify the stories we’re sharing. Today, the podcast is powered by KEDCO and DreamOn Studios in partnership with Tippy River Adventures & Visit Kosciusko County.

Since launching in late 2020, The Clearly Kosciusko Podcast has featured more than **80 GUESTS** from nearly **30 DIFFERENT INDUSTRIES**, and produced nearly **70 EPISODES**.

TRANSFORMATIVE PROJECT

South Shore Village KEDCO worked alongside South Shore Ventures LLC to distribute a request for proposals to developers for a 112-acre mixed use site at the former South Shore Golf Course in Syracuse. The conceptual site plan includes single-family housing and commercial space.

COMPANY HIGHLIGHTS

In June 2023, Paragon Medical celebrated its new 34,000 SF additive manufacturing facility in Pierceton with a ribbon cutting and grand opening event. The company invested more than \$16M in the project and anticipates investing an additional \$19M over the next five years.

In March 2023, global company, Mentor Supply Chain USA (Mentor Media) celebrated a groundbreaking event for its medical device packaging and supply chain solutions facility located in a portion of the 100,000 SF shell building at Warsaw Technology Park.

TALENT: SHOWING WHAT KOSCIUSKO COUNTY HAS TO OFFER

KEDCO led an effort for Kosciusko County to join with Indiana-based MakeMyMove to recruit remote workers from out-of-state. KEDCO and MakeMyMove launched the program in late 2022 and four out-of-state families have already committed to moving to the community.

In May of 2023, KEDCO hosted its first Community Showcase event for out-of-town corporate recruiters who haven't yet had the chance to visit Kosciusko County. These events provide an up-close glimpse of our community. Nearly a dozen recruiters have participated since launching the program in the spring.

IMPACT STORY

KEDCO helped connect several local employers to Manufacturing Readiness Grants, which support companies in pursuing "smart manufacturing" investments.

The program is managed by Conexus Indiana in partnership with the Indiana Economic Development Corporation and Next Level Manufacturing Institute.

To-date, 10+ Kosciusko County companies have received grants.
